TALK

Developing your child's oral language skills is an integral part of preparing for Pre-K and kindergarten. Engage your child in discussion about the world around him. Ask questions. Talk about nature, letters, numbers, and feelings. Encourage your child to make eye contact and greet others with a "Hello" and a "Goodbye."



TIME TO PRACTICE

Give your child time away from you. Practice separating and giving your child a little bit of space. Make time for play dates and opportunities that allow your child to spend time with other children their age.







PLAY AND EXPLORE

We believe in the power of play!
From games to imaginative play, our classrooms will be filled with expression. To prepare, spend time playing with your child. Encourage pretend play and role-playing. Laugh and have fun together. Offer your child playtime to herself, giving the opportunity to decide what to do.









WAYS TO PREPARE FOR PRE-**KINDERGARTEN**



- ✓ Work on fine motor skills with play dough, Legos, sand, etc.
- Practice social skills such as sharing and taking turns.
- Help them take responsibility for cleaning messes and getting dressed.

Teach problem-solving strategies.

- Build self-esteem by allowing struggles and overcoming obstacles.
- Learn to follow two-step directions.
- Practice advocating. Teach them to ask for the things that they need.
- Use good manners.

What Can We Work On

PERSONAL CARE

- Use the restroom independently and practice good hygiene
- Button and connect the clasp on skirts, shorts, or pants
- Open lunch and snack containers

SOCIAL EMOTIONAL

- Interact positively with peers and adults
- Ask for help
- Handle emotions appropriately

ACADEMIC

- Letter recognition
- Recognize their name in print
- Identify colors and shapes
- Count objects one at a time
- Sit and listen for 5 to 10 minutes
- Follow simple directions

- Crayons
- Scissors
- Glue
